It's making sure to keep the right kind of secrets to protect your loved one's.


As a family member of the military community, you are an important player in the success of OPSEC!


Don't forget about your mail!!!

If you need help or are lost, always go to a safe adult, like a police officer, soldier or teacher.




Talk with your parents about safety and security! Always lock your doors, windows and never give out personal information to anyone over the internet.
